PLAYA GRANDE BEACH CLUB

Río San Juan, Dominican Republic

Hidden along the Dominican Republic's pristine northern coastline, this collection of pastel-hued bungalows brings Palm Beach wonderment to a tropical jungle setting. Designer Celerie Kemble weaves together antiques with elegant accents like light fixtures crafted from dried fruits. A textural highlight is the bar lined with pressed seashells. BROADWICK SOHO London

An eight-floor hotel with interiors by Martin Brudnizki, this vibrant property emulates an eccentric townhouse dripping with flamboyant print pairings and riotous hues. One enters through a coral pink door and lands in a world of rich cultural references and playful details, including the hotel's own elephant motif.
