Hidden along the Dominican Republic's pristine northern coastline, this collection of pastel-hued bungalows brings Palm Beach wonderment to a tropical jungle setting. Designer Celerie Kemble weaves together antiques with elegant accents like light fixtures crafted from dried fruits. A textural highlight is the bar lined with pressed seashells.
